#### **Duration and Commencement**

These Master's degree scholarships are available for a maximum of TWO (2) YEARS. The scholarships will initially be granted for ONE (1) YEAR and may be extended upon individual request and receipt of a complete application made on the provided form

#### **Equal Opportunities**

Female candidates and candidates from less privileged regions or groups as well as candidates with disabilities are especially encouraged to apply.
